### Friday, August 5, 2016

Opening ceremonies are at Bernie Arbour Stadium; 12pm (arrive at 11:45am). The Stadium is located at the corner of Upper Kenilworth and Mohawk Road East. Parking is east of the intersection on the right.

The billeting process will occur after the ceremonies and the Hamilton Athletes will be matched with their Flint guests. The Hamilton hosts will be responsible for the care of the Flint athlete. They will feed the Flint athlete lunch and dinner on Friday. They will be responsible for getting the athletes to the competitions. Game times will be updated on the website and Facebook page. The athletes need to be in their host’s home for their 11pm curfew.

### Saturday, August 6, 2016

Hamilton Hosts are responsible for Flint athletes breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Competitions will be played at various times this day.

The free time after competitions is open for the host families to organize the activities of their choosing. Examples: mall, movies, team BBQs, Festival of Friends at AncasterFairgrounds, etc. The athletes need to be in their host’s home for their 11pm curfew.

### Sunday, August 7, 2016

The hosts are responsible for the Flint athlete’s breakfast and some snacks for the ride home. Closing ceremonies are at 9am at Mohawk College west parking lot. The College is located at the corner of Fennell Ave. E. & West 5<sup>th</sup>. The Flint athletes will board their busses directly following the ceremonies.
